NUC 10	Queen seen. LB no eggs. 1 brood, 3 stores, 1 room	RI. Fed.	
2	Queen not seen. No brood. 6 stores, 4 room. Note: Queen seen 01 September when was 1 frame brood.	RI. 1 frames room replaced with frame of eggs and larva from hive 3. Fed.	Check to see if evidence of a queen present with a view to uniting if Q not present.

Key: Q = queen. QC = queen cell. E = eggs. L = open larva. B = sealed brood.
