1	6 Brood. No Q cells	None	Check for Q cells & room in supers
5	4 Brood. Congested in Brood Box	Removed Q cells, changed brood frame to give Q more room to lay	Check for Q cells & room in supers
3	7 Brood. 2 Supers	Removed 3 Q cells	Check for Q cells & room in supers
7	5 Brood. Q seen, 3 Q cells seen and left as supercedure.. 1 Super	Hive 2 (above) removed following unite. (Hive 2 suspect drone laying worker so shaken out nearby)	Check for room in super but do not open Brood chamber for 3 weeks
6	4 Brood	Moved from Nuc box to 14/12 Brood box with extra frames	Check for Q cells & may need a super
9	6 Brood. No Q cells. 2 Supers	None	Check for Q cells & room in supers

Notes: Frames and H2 box sit outside awaiting Oxalic clean. All other kit from Apiary (including feeder ekes cleaned/scorched and stored)

Gas cylinder for flame torch returned to container, will need refill at AVS Fencing, before next cleaning session. We don't have a blow torch though.
