9	Q not seen. No eggs. 6 Supers. No queen in Qunitex cage 😞 Still bad tempered.	8QX, 2QL, Quintex removed (1 pin broken)	Look for signs of supersedure but note new one will be direct descendant of Mrs Grumpy.
1a Nuc	QNS Eggs seen, No larvae sealed brood Possibly newly laying/ mated queen	Q2X	Check for presence of Q and for eggs & larvae. If Q Seen consider marking & clipping soon.
