1	Q not seen. ELS. 8 brood frames A lot of play cups on one frame.	RI. Didn't need extra super	RI. Maybe add fourth super.
2	Q not seen. Frame of eggs donated last week now all sealed brood. All other frames = no ELS	RI. No QCs. Bees think they are queen right.	Look for signs of queen. Consider uniting if none.
3	Q seen. 9 brood 1 stores. ELS. 4 supers	RI. Dealt with wax moth.	RI
4	Q not seen. No QCs. ELS. 6 brood, 2stores, 2room.	RI. Donated frame of eggs to hive 6. Didn't need another super.	RI. Add third super if needed.
5	Q not seen. ELS. 3 brood, 7 room, 1 stores. QCs.	Removed 4 QCs, left 1 open, charged QC. Believe supercedure taking place.	Check emergency QCs. QC was left on frame marked with an X.
6	No ELS. Q not seen. 1 QC but not viable.	Frame of eggs from hive 4 placed centrally	Check middle frame for sign of queen rearing. If yes leave to develop.
7	Top box: Q not seen. ELS. 3 brood, 1.5 stores. In middle of Bailey Comb Change.	Top box not ready for extra frame. Lower brood box not opened.	Consider adding further frame(s) to top brood box. Inspect lower brood box. Consider next steps.
Nuc 6	Q seen. 4 brood, 1 stores	Added frame as per instruction. Now no room for dummy board.	RI
